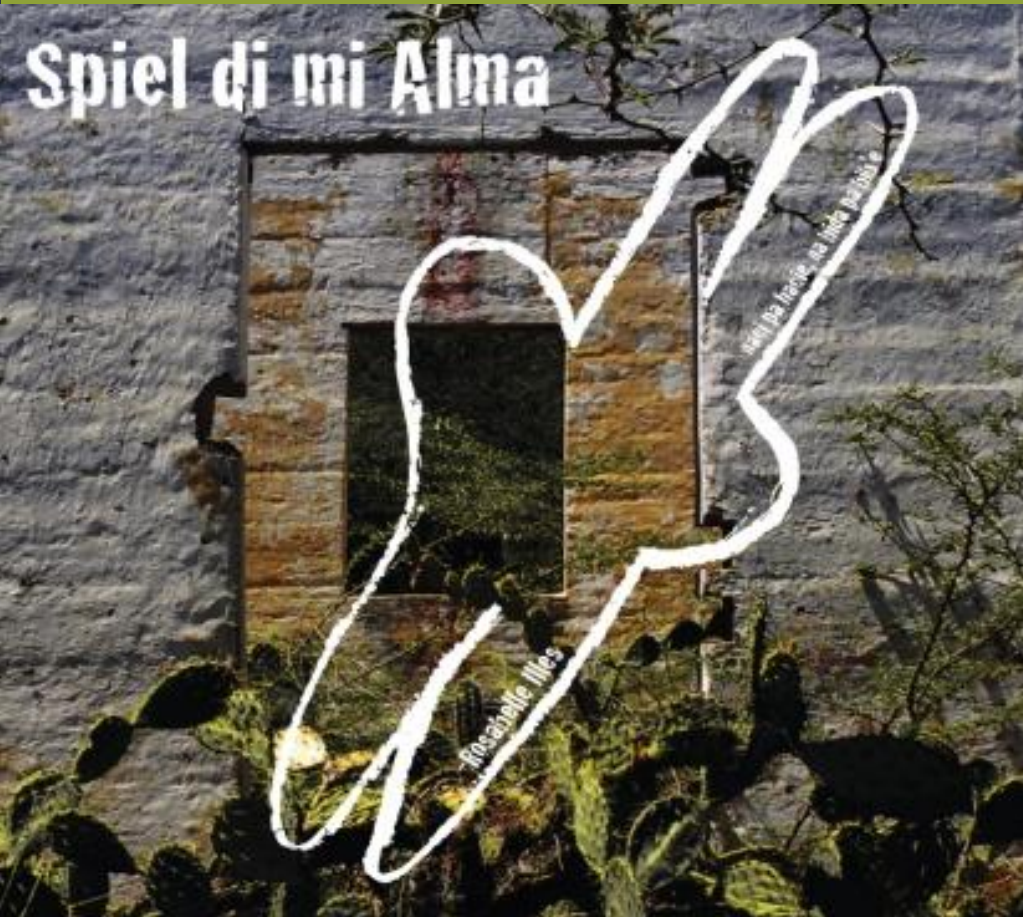

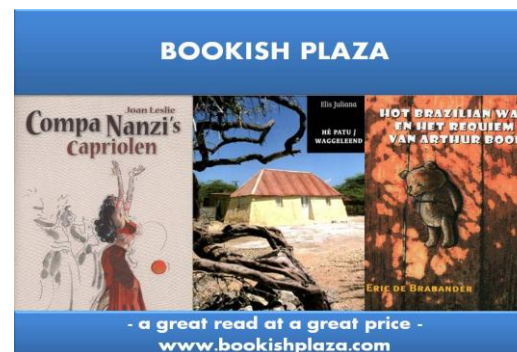
WELCOME TO BOOKISH PLAZA

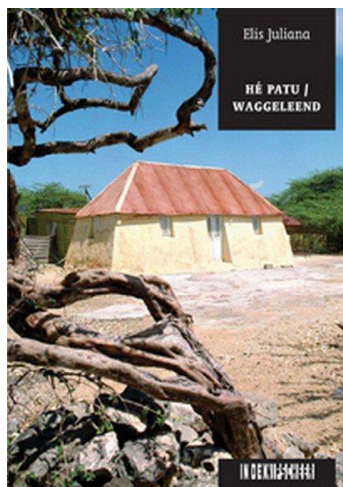


VOETSTAPPEN OP DE ROTS

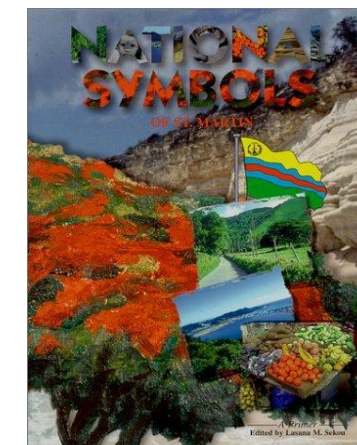
Verborgen Leegte Popular

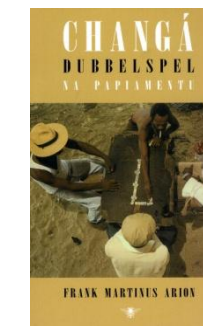
Another news is that the book has been distributed among the libraries in The Netherlands by the NBD/Biblion. A second edition has been recently printed.

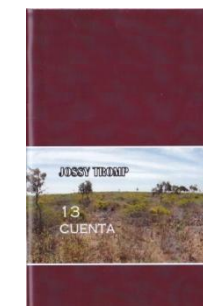

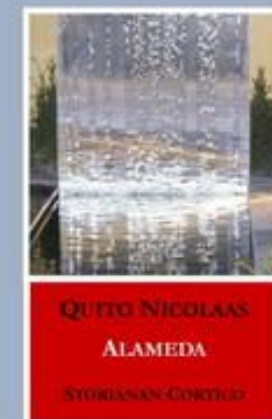
