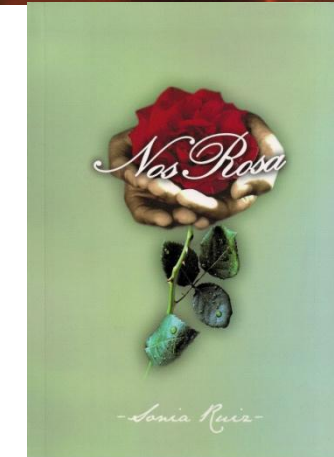

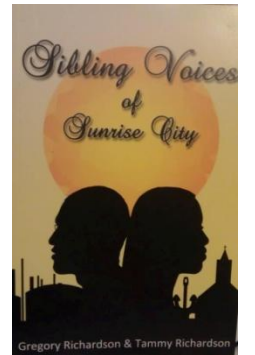
Nos Rosa Sonia Ruiz

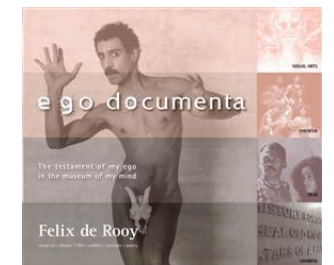

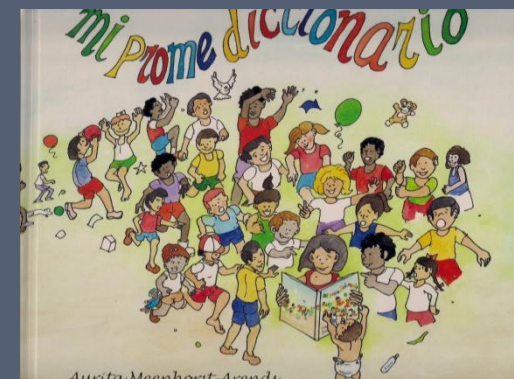
